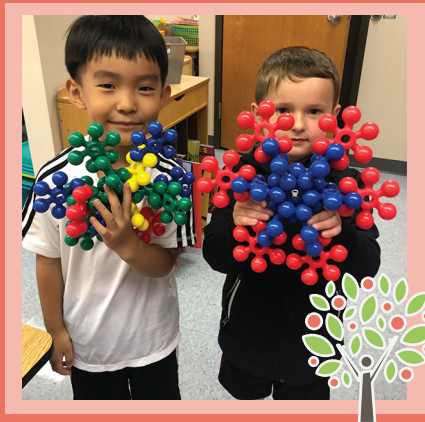
\$50 Friend of the Foundation

Supports two students to participate in real life classroom experiences, like a program that allows young students to explore everyday professions through the National Geographic REACH program.



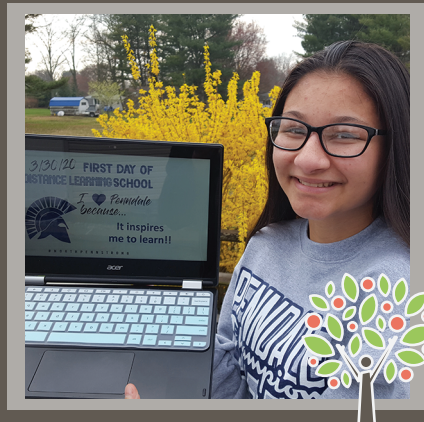
\$150 Supporter of the Foundation
