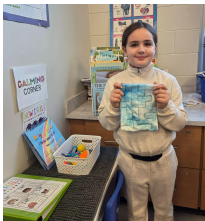

Calming Corners - Calming corners are designated safe spaces where students can practice self-regulation and mindfulness techniques when feeling overwhelmed, anxious, or emotionally dysregulated. By providing developmentally appropriate tools and resources, these spaces promote emotional well-being, increase classroom engagement, and support a trauma-sensitive learning environment with sensory tools, calming furniture, visual aids, and mindfulness materials at Knapp Elementary.



Hands In Clay - Creating Storytelling Tiles - Students explored the art of ceramics while connecting personal narratives and cultural storytelling to visual art through this hands-on and engaging activity. Students designed and created their own clay tiles, embedding unique designs, symbols, and textures that reflect their identity and imagination at Penfield Middle School.



The Peer Connections Mentorship Program - Escape Room - The Mentorship Program pairs high school leadership students with elementary and middle school peers to build confidence, social skills, and positive relationships. Through bi-monthly sessions, including a trip to an escape room, high school mentors act as relatable role models, guiding younger students in navigating social challenges while gaining hands-on leadership experience themselves.
